Order low-cost shade trees and plant trees in your community and have them delivered to your door. Projects may include tree planting in street rights-of-way, neighborhood and community places, parks and schools. Grow beautiful, comfortable, healthy and sustainable public spaces by planting shade trees that cool communities and help reduce the Urban Heat Island Effect.

All trees require water to become established and many trees require ongoing irrigation throughout their lives. Maximize available water by providing basins or tree wells that harvest available surface runoff and grow wider as the tree canopy expands. Trees may need occasional pruning, but do not prune during first two years (unless structural) to encourage trunk development. Before Planting your Trees

You must obtain approval from property owners and/or site custodians. Plant trees at least 10 ft. from sewer lines, 5 ft. from water lines, and 3 ft. from other utility lines. Do not plant under overhead lines. Do not plant in public right-of-way without permit & Blue Stake clearance (dial 811 or 1-800-782-5348). Permits may be required for public sites such as streetscapes and waterways, please call (520)791-3109 for further assistance in advance of your project. Unless you are planting where trees were previously located, you MUST have potential planting area Blue Staked prior to planting. This service is free of charge.

Quantity	Size	Variety	
	<input type="checkbox"/> 5 gal	Desert Willow, <i>Chilopsis linearis</i> (deciduous)	Native; fast growth up to 20' tall; attractive pink flowers from spring to fall; drops leaves in winter; low pollen; no thorns; low maintenance; multi-trunk; grey bark; willow-like leaves.
	<input type="checkbox"/> 5 gal	White Thorn Acacia, <i>Acacia constricta</i> (deciduous)	Slow growing, long lived small tree reaching 10-20 ft tall and wide. Inch long white thorns, small, feathery, winter deciduous leaves. Yellow fragrant puffball flowers in spring, thin red-brown pods. Tolerates poor soil. Great for smaller spaces ie: under power lines.
	<input type="checkbox"/> 5 gal	Blue Palo Verde, <i>Parkinsonia florida</i> (deciduous)	Native; moderate-fast growth to 30' tall; yellow flowers in spring; blue-green colored bark; tiny thorns; typically multi-trunked; mild allergen; seed pods; low litter; upright growth; can be susceptible to palo verde borer, witches' broom, and mistletoe.
	<input type="checkbox"/> 5 gal	Velvet Mesquite, <i>Prosopis Velutina</i> (deciduous)	Native; moderate growth to 30' tall; slightly fragrant flowers; drops most leaves in winter; higher pollen; seed & pod litter; edible pods; thorns; multi-trunk; deep roots.
	<input type="checkbox"/> 5 gal	Nettleleaf Hackberry, <i>Celtis reticulata</i> (deciduous)	Native, moderate growth, to 30' tall, full sun, moderate water. Attracts native song birds with pea sized red berries. Distinctive warty gray bark on mature trees. Thornless.
	<input type="checkbox"/> 5 gal	Desert Ironwood, <i>Olneya tesota</i>	Native; slow initial growth then faster growth after 1 st year; up to 25' tall; evergreen; white-grey bark and green leaves; recurved thorns; purple flowers in summer. Very long-lived. Hardy to 15 ° F. NOTE: At present, these trees are very small (3' or less).
	<input type="checkbox"/> 5 gal	Catclaw Acacia, <i>Acacia greggii</i> (semi-deciduous)	Native; moderate growth to 15' tall; fragrant yellow/cream oblong puffs; drought; pods curl when dry; hooked horns; multi-trunk; very drought tolerant, sculptural trunk. Attracts birds.
	<input type="checkbox"/> 5 gal	Heritage Pomegranate, <i>Punica granatum</i> (deciduous)	Non native heritage fruit tree, moderate growth, low water, to 12' tall, full sun, edible fruit. No thorns, hardy to 15° F. Bright red flowers and fruit; good as hedging; attracts birds. Not for use as a street tree.
	<input type="checkbox"/> 5 gal	Heritage Fig (<i>Ficus indica</i>) (deciduous)	Note: Please educate yourself about special care requirements of fruit trees including higher water-use, fertilization (if any), pruning, etc. Not for use as a street tree.
